The new, revised and extended second edition of "Xenotransplantation" provides a complete overview of this promising and exciting field of transplantation. The book is written and edited by internationally renowned scientists and provides an up-to-date multidisciplinary review.

Different sections of the book focus on immunological, pathological, and some physiological aspects of xenotransplantation within concordant or discordant animal combinations. Observations are made regarding the suitability of major parenchymal organs for xenotransplantation. First results of pharmacological and genetic approaches

are also included. The book closes with a discussion of ethical aspects and a summary of clinical experiences.

Thus, this work uniquely puts into perspective the essential features of xenotransplantation and its, as yet, unresolved problems. It provides comprehensive coverage for both newcomers and advanced scientists working in the field of xenotransplantation.
