Sandoz Study Grant

The ESOT Council and representatives of Sandoz have discussed the future of the fellowship and agreed to the following changes: The new name will be the *Sandoz Study Grant*. All individuals involved in the field of transplantation will be eligible for the study grant. There will have to be a specific purpose with a clear study goal, and the period for which an applicant may apply for financial support can vary from one to several weeks or months. The leaders of both centers will not necessarily have to be members of the Society. Congress visits will be excluded from this study grant.

Applications for the study grant have to be submitted in English, have to be well documented (curriculum vitae, etc.), and have to specify the purpose of the study. The Council will decide whether a proposal meets the goal of the Sandoz Study Grant and grant recipients will be selected by the Council.
