For the first time ever, The Louisville Microsurgery Teaching Course will be held in Europe.

- What: Student will be instructed on essential microsurgical technique using:
- Hands-on instruction and practice in live vessels.
 - One-on-one instruction from and experienced microsurgeon. Limited to five students per 5-day course.
 - Video tape assisted instruction and take-home course instruction hand book.
 - Taught using then latest Zeiss OPMI Vario/S 88 clinical operating microscopes and the S&T microsurgical instruments.
 - A take-home video recording or photograph of you performing key anastomoses for later review.
 - Certificate verifying the completion of the course.
- Where: Johann Wolfgang Goethe University, Frankfurt am Main, Germany.
- When: Two 5-day courses held on August 4–8 and August 11–15, 2008.
- Whom: For beginners in microsurgery as well as experienced microsurgeons who want to strengthen or upgrade their skills.
