Pamela Falger-Cohen died on May 14, 2011, in Schin op Geul, The Netherlands. She was the Assistant to the Editor-in-Chief of *Transplant International* from its beginnings in November 1987 to 1998. In these 11 years she was the driving force behind the new journal.

Pamela was born in 1954 in New York, where she studied English as a second language. Her editing was meticulous, a priceless asset for a new international journal stemming from Holland. To encourage publishing in *Transplant International*, she attended the meetings of the European Society for Organ Transplantation, where she staffed a well-visited booth. Thanks to her energy and devotion, the journal made an excellent start and has since then developed to a top international forum for publication and discussion on transplantation.

Pamela bequeaths a husband and two sons at the beginning of an academic career.
